

How To Properly Store Hay

TO PRESERVE MAXIMUM FRESHNESS

- Store Hay In The Dark
 - Sunlight exposure can decrease the nutrient content of hay. We recommend storing it in a dark place, like a closet, to prevent it from losing nutrients and becoming sun bleached.
- Store Hay In a Dry Place
 In order to prevent mold and bacteria growth, it is important that hay is stored in a dry location with plenty of air circulation. Hay should not be stored in an air tight container.
- Store Hay In a Temperature Controlled Environment

Mold and bacteria growth can increase when exposed to warmth and moisture. Our hay is all moisture tested prior to packaging, however, prolonged storage in a humid climate can cause mold growth.
